



About Surg & Rad Techs

Surgical Technologists

- Assist in operations by passing instruments and supplies to surgeons; hold equipment during surgery; anticipate surgeon's needs
- Sets up sterile operating environments, including instruments and supplies
- Prep and drape patients for surgery
- Equipment maintenance, testing, and setup

Radiologic Technologists and Technicians

- Use medical equipment to take diagnostic images and scans of patients
- May administer nonradioactive materials for diagnostic purposes
- Includes x-ray technicians and radiologic technologists
- Different specialties: x-ray, MRI, CT, sonography, mammography, cardiac or vascular interventional, etc.




